They were surfing when it started to rain.
- 2- Mom was cutting some vegetables (**while**) she cut her finger. (Correct the mistake)
Mom was cutting some vegetables when she cut her finger.
- 3- Could I speak to the manager?
Sure (Agree)
I am sorry, but he is busy now. (Refuse)
